35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of his dis•ci•ples;

36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!

37 And the two dis•ci•ples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.

38 Then Jesus turned, and saw them fol•low•ing, and saith unto them, **What seek ye?** They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being in•ter•pre•ted, Master,) where dwellest thou?

39 He saith unto them, **Come and see.** They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.
