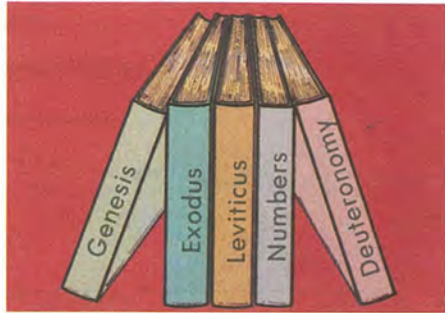

Moses wrote these books as he was directed by God.

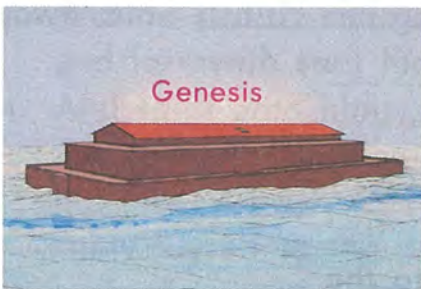


Five Books of the Law

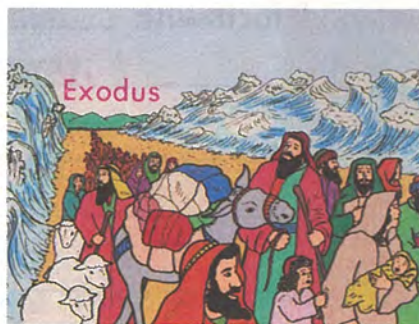


They were probably written on paper made of leaves (papyrus) or animal skins.

Genesis is known as the book of "beginnings." Genesis tells the beginning of the heavens, earth, plants, animals, and people.

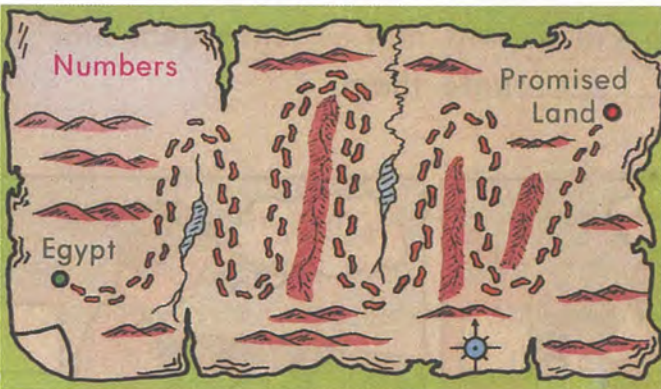


Exodus is known as the book of "going out." Exodus tells about the Israelites' escape from Egypt.



Leviticus is known as the book of "worship." God tells the Israelites how to worship.

Numbers is known as the book of the Israelites' "wilderness wanderings."



Deuteronomy is known as the book of "remembrance." Moses gives his last words to the Israelites before they enter the Promised Land.
